Subject: Comments on Electrical Energy Tariffs

Kosova Flour Millers Association ,hereinafter KFMA has 97 factories for wheat milling with the following capacities:

- * Annual milling 1.426.000 metric tons;
- * Grains deposition 231.000 metric tons / 1 charge
- * Flour Deposition 131.000 metric tons / 1 charge

Republic Of Kosova should establish conditions for utilisation of these capacities on disposal which are being used 25-27% during the past 8 years.

One of the required working conditions for Milling Industry respectively flour mills of Kosova is the electrical energy.

We have following remarks regarding the proposed tariffs:

- 1. To flour Millers category that have their own substations and group meters, the categories (where the energy price has been 50% cheaper compared to the domestic customers due to the wholesale consumption) have been changed twice.**
- 2. Those category changes have resulted in the electrical energy price increase by 200%. These increases have equilized us with German domestic customers.**
- 3. You have equilized approximately all categories through these proposals.**
- 4. You have made the changes without consulting the Milling Industry (millers). The category change should have been consulted for in particular.**

The miller's history shows that countries where electrical energy price, the millers do not work due to the fact that imported flour is cheaper than production with expensive prices of electrical energy. We hope you will not bring the Milling Industry of Kosova in a situation of not being able to produce.

We are interested to have a meeting with you relative to consultations regarding the aforementioned items and others.
