Taking into account:

1. The provisions of the Law No. 2004/8 “On Energy”;
2. The provisions of the Law No.2004/9 “On the Energy Regulator”;
3. The provisions of the Temporary Instruction I_02_2005 “On the Principles of Calculation of Tariffs and Prices in the District Heating Sector in Kosovo for the Heating Season 2005/2006”;
4. Tariff application for heat tariffs for the season 2005/2006 submitted by Public Municipal Utility (PMU) Standard / District Heating Unit (DHU) Termomit to Energy Regulatory Office (ERO) on 5th October, 2005;
5. Revised tariff application in the meeting of 30th October between ERO and PMU Standard
6. Determination of Allowed Revenues for PMU Standard / DHU Termomit for Heating Season 2005/2006, issued by ERO on 22nd of November 2005, accompanied by ANNEX I “REGULATORY REPORT – Methodology and Price Review for Determination of Allowed Revenues for PMU Standard / DHU Termomit, for Heating Season 2005/2006”;

Has decided to:

1. Approve the tariff rates for PMU Standard / DHU Termomit for the whole of the six months of the Heating Season 2005/2006 as presented in the Table “A” and “B” and detailed calculation presented in ANNEX II “ REGULATORY REPORT – Tariff setting for PMU Standard / DHU Termomit for Heating Season 2005/2006” to this decision.
2. The approved tariff rates, shall be published by PMU Standard / DHU Termomit, in one national and one local daily newspapers circulated in Kosovo, within five (5) working days after the Energy Regulatory Office’s announcement and publication of the decision on the official ERO’s website.
3. Energy Regulatory Office (ERO) will make use of the rights given by the law, to verify presented data and audit accounts and invoices of PMU Standard / DHU Termomit on which the calculation of the tariff rates during the coming heating period is based.
4. During the heating season 2005/2006 PMU Standard / DHU Termomit may present to the Energy Regulatory Office proposal for justified changes in its approved tariff, according to Temporary Instruction I_02_2005 “On the Principles of Calculation of Tariffs and Prices in the District Heating Sector in Kosovo for the Heating Season 2005/2006” issued on August 10th, 2005.

5. PMU Standard / DHU Termomit has the right to appeal to ERO by submitting a fully substantiated report, within ten (10) calendar days after the announcement and publication of the decision on the official ERO's website.
