THE 7th SESSION FOR THIS YEAR OF THE BOARD OF ENERGY REGULATORY OFFICE

Today, on 30 September 2020, the Board of Energy Regulatory Office held its seventh (7th) consecutive session for this year.

In this session, the Board approved the Rule on Nomination of Electricity Market Operator (NEMO) for carrying out activities related to market integration and its operation. This rule defines the criteria and procedures for the nomination, by the Regulator, of this operator in the Republic of Kosovo and defines the tasks that this operator will perform in relation to the electricity market coupling process. The adoption of this rule is of particular importance in accelerating the functioning of the common energy market between the Republic of Kosovo and that of Albania.

The Board also approved the requests of 7 applicants for construction of a total of 160kW generating capacities for self-consumption by solar panels in the municipalities of Prishtina, Peja and Gjakova.

The request of the Kosovo Energy Corporation (KEK) JSC for the extension of Electricity Generation License from TPP "Kosova A" for another year and the request for Electricity Wholesale Supply (Trade) License of the enterprise "Bindi Integrated Services" LLC were also approved in this session.

Part of the review and approval of the Board was also the amendment of the Transmission Connection Charging Methodology and the request of the Transmission System and Market Operator (TSO-KOSTT) for derogation of the Electricity long-term Balance and Generation Adequacy Plan.

The Board also reviewed some customer complaints as well as other issues related to the functioning of the Energy Regulatory Office.
