The Board of Energy Regulatory Office,

based on:

- Provisions of Article 15, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 1.5, paragraphs 3 and 4, Article 25, Article 26, paragraph 1, sub-paragraph 1.2 and Article 51 of the Law on Energy Regulator (Law no.05/L-084);
- Provisions of Article 3, paragraph 1, sub-paragraphs 51 and 72, Article 5, Article 33, paragraph 4, sub-paragraph 4.1, Article 37, Article 38 and Article 62, paragraph 7 of the Law on Electricity (Law no. 05/L-085);
- Rule no. 15/2017 on Determination of Revenues of the Universal Service Supplier (USS);
- Provisions of Article 17 of the electricity supply license, issued to the company "KOSOVO ELECTRICITY SUPPLY COMPANY" (KESCo) J.S.C, with license number ZRRE/Tr_2014/Li_07/17, dated on 27.04.2017;
- Evaluation of electricity market concentration through HHI (herfindahl-hirschman index) for 2023;

in the session held on 23 March 2023 issued the following:

DECISION

ON IMPOSITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE OBLIGATION

- I. Imposition of the Public Service Obligation to the electricity supply licensee "KOSOVO ELECTRICITY SUPPLY COMPANY" J.S.C (hereinafter "KESCo") for supply of final customers entitled to universal service.
- **II.** The right to universal service is entitled to:
 - a. all household customers;
 - b. Non-household customers with annual turnover less than ten million euros (10,000,000 €) and less than fifty (50) employees;
- **III.** Regardless of point II of the enacting clause of this Decision, all final customers are entitled to be supplied with electricity in the competitive market.
- **IV.** The Regulator will regulate the electricity prices of the customers entitled to supply within universal service, which cover the reasonable costs of electricity supply.
- **V.** The level of electricity supply costs and prices will be reviewed in annual basis, in line with the Rule on Determination of Revenues for the Universal Service Supplier.





- VI. The supplier charged with Public Service Obligation, according to this Decision is obliged to:
 - a. supply electricity as public service according to the criteria set through this decision, the license as well as other applicable legislation.
 - b. inform customers (purchasers) on their rights and supply criteria within the universal service;
 - c. supply electricity of a certain quality, according to Service and Supply Quality Standards;
 - d. bill the electricity delivered in line with prices set by the Regulator;
 - e. publish the tariffs on its website, at least fifteen (15) days prior to starting the application of them.
- VII. This decision will be an integral part of the Electricity Supply License, issued to "KESCo";
- VIII. The obligation imposed to KESCO, according to this decision, is set for a period of one (1) year and is implemented from **01.04.2023** until **31.03.2024**.

REASONING

- Due to the lack of effective competition and with the purpose of providing sustainable electricity supply and protection of customers, the Regulator, on 27 April 2017 (Decision V_916_2017) imposed to KESCO, for a three (3) year period, from 01.04.2017 until 31.03.2020, the Public Service Obligation for provision of electricity supply as a Universal Service.
- Through the Decision V_1268_2020, dated on 03 July 2020, due to the reasons related to COVID-19 Pandemic, the Public Service Obligation was extended to KESCO for one (1) additional year, covering the period from 01.04.2020 until 31.03.2021. The Energy Community Secretariat was also notified of this decision.
- Due to the lack of the absence of the quorum of ERO Board to handle this issue, ERO, through
 official communication (e-mail dated on 31 March 2021) notified KEDS that the obligation remains
 until the completion of ERO Board.
- Through the Decision no. 1419_2021, issued at the Board session on 07.10.2021, the Public Service
 Obligation as a Universal Service Supplier was extended to KESCo until 31.03. 2022.
- Through the Decision no. V_1501_2022, issued at the Board session dated on 31.03.2022, KESCo's Public Service Obligation as a Universal Service Supplier was extended for one (1) year, starting from 01.04. 2022 until 31.03.2023.
- On 23 March 2023, the Regulator reviewed the document Evaluation of the concentration of electricity market in Kosovo through the HHI index (herfindahl-hirschman index) for the year 2022. The evaluation is based on the calculation of market concentration indices, such as market share(MS), concentration ratio (CRn), Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI), Main Supplier Index (PSI) and Residual Supply Index (RSI), and this evaluation shows that the wholesale and retail electricity market still continue to face a lack of competition and high concentration.





- Therefore, taking into account the above-mentioned circumstances and based on the legislation in force mentioned in the introductory section of this Decision as well as the operational capabilities of KESCO to provide electricity supply as a Universal Service, the Regulator has decided to impose to KESCO the Public Service Obligation for the provision of electricity supply as a Universal Service, as in the enacting clause of this Decision.
- **IX.** The decision is issued in official languages of the Republic of Kosovo.
- **X.** The decision shall enter into force on the date of approval by the Board and will be published on the official website of ERO.
